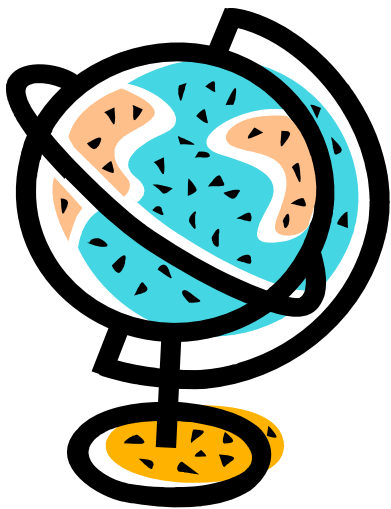


What services are provided by Outreach staff?

What is the Outreach Program?

The goal of the school-based Outreach worker is to provide preventive and supportive services to students and their families within the school district. The Outreach Program is designed to provide short term intervention to students and their families to alleviate barriers that are affecting the student's academic and overall potential.



Who can refer a child to Outreach?

The individuals that can refer students are school staff, students, parents, and self-referrals.

How are referrals made to Outreach?

In the elementary grades each school has a designated contact person to manage Outreach referrals and monitor progress. Parent permission must be obtained in writing before Outreach services can begin. Please contact the school office for more specific information.



What are reasons to refer a child to Outreach?

Students whose academic performance or social functioning is impaired by behavior or emotional difficulties would be one reason to refer a child to the Outreach Program. Other reasons would be aggression, anger, non-compliance, sadness, withdrawn behavior, poor social skills and family dynamics.
