

TRUANCY ELIMINATION PLAN

The Truancy Elimination Plan is developed immediately after the School Outreach worker is notified of the unexcused absences. If the unexcused absences continue and a citation is issued, the Outreach worker will attend the hearing to inform the District Judge of the family's compliance. The District Judge will order the fine but suspend the disposition with the assurance the family will participate with the services offered by the Outreach worker.
